Board of Elder Minutes

October 29, 2012

Members present: Rev. Don Griffin, Bobbie Reid, Dwight Deal, Cindy Johnson, Karen Kapp, Sylvia Ridge, Walter Carter; absent: Pam Hensdale, David Long.

Rev. Griffin shared a devotional, and numerous prayer concerns of the congregation were updated before prayer.

Updates:

- Outreach Ministry The Outreach Ministry's 12 visitation teams were well-received by the Weatherstone
 neighborhood during their canvassing done October 4-9. Numerous visitors from the Weatherstone and
 surrounding neighborhoods also attended the chicken stew at UCMC October 20. Pastor Don will be sending a
 follow-up letter to Weatherstone residents and other visitors as we continue to invite the community to join us for
 worship and ministry. The Outreach ministry group will meet November 18 (Sunday 3-4 PM) to plan the next
 community canvass on December 2 to invite the community to our Advent and Christmas services.
- Vacation Request Pastor Don asked and received permission from the Elders to be away November 3-10. Dwight Deal will conduct the 11:00 worship service on November 4 as Beth Hinesley, from Carolina Donor Services, will present information regarding the importance of choosing to be an organ donor.
- SOP for use of Supplementary Buildings Cindy Johnson agreed to serve on a committee with Terry Tucker and a Trustee (TBA) to develop standard operating procedures (SOP) for the use of the supplementary buildings of the overall church facilities (Scout Hut, Picnic Pavilion, Flinchum house, After School Center).

- Veterans Day Bobbie Reid and Dee McGee have compiled a special Veterans Day booklet with the information received from many UCMC veterans. Copies (150) will be printed to distribute on Veterans Day, November 11, to the veterans, families, and church members. The 11:00 worship service will include recognition of our veterans with a potluck luncheon afterwards in the fellowship hall.
- Wednesday night Bible Study A new Bible study opportunity will begin January 9, 2013. Pastor Don, Anita Whittington, Steve Williams, and Marcia Williams will rotate as the leader of the evening Bible study each week. Plans include having a simple meal available each week from 6:00-6:45 pm prepared by volunteers. Hopefully four different ministry groups will come forward and rotate the responsibility for the Wednesday night meals. Bible Study will be 7:00-7:45 pm.
- Regional Council of Churches (RCC) The Fall Festival/Trunk or Treat at Friedland on October 28 was very well attended. Plans continue to assist hosting Carter G. Woodson Charter School with a Lovefeast service at Pine Chapel Moravian.
- Youth Holiday Festival Request The Youth asked to host a breakfast and outside-holiday-vendor fundraiser on December 8. Proceeds would help fund a 2013 Youth mission trip. The Elders agreed to the proposal but required the date be moved to December 1 due to events already on the church calendar.
- **Request from Casey Brown** The Elders agreed to permit Casey Brown to use the kitchen and fellowship hall on November 19, for a fundraiser for the Glenn High School Future Business People of America club.

Ministry Reports:

- Hospitality The annual Christmas singing and pot luck is planned for Sunday, December 9 at 5:00 pm.
- **Christian Education** Dot Tucker has recruited volunteers to participate in a Christmas play to be performed at the 11:00 worship service on December 9. Play practice will begin November 10.
- **Family Ministries** Bobbie Reid will contact Union Cross Academy to identify families in need of assistance this Christmas. The Elders agreed the offering received at the Thanksgiving Eve Lovefeast would be used for this purpose as well as a love offering collected Sunday, November 25. Sunday school classes wanting to sponsor additional families should contact Bobbie Reid.
- School Ministries Both the Preschool and the Afterschool programs have exceeded anticipated enrollment this fall. Congratulations to both Directors; Kristi Whittington and Amanda Griffin.
- Praise & Worship The Elders discussed the possibility of establishing a paid position to have someone
 responsible for the Praise music each Sunday comparable to the financial support given to the traditional worship
 service's adult choir director and organists. A motion was made, seconded, and passed to recommend such a
 position be considered by the Board of Trustees. If the Trustees agree, a formal job description will be written
 prior to accepting applications for the position.

Board of Trustees' Minutes

November 12, 2012

Karen Vaughn opened the meeting with devotions.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> – Lisa presented the financial statement for the period ending October, 2012, as well as the budget for 2013. The Board discussed various items relating to the upcoming budget and agreed to review the budget during the next month and vote on it at the December meeting. The Board agreed with Lisa's recommendation that a check scanner for processing of Sunday offerings is not needed at this time.

<u>Proposed Additional Church Positions</u> – The Board discussed two suggestions regarding adding two positions to the church's budget: a Praise and Worship Leader and a Cleaning/Building and Grounds Employee. Upon a motion by Charles and second by Paige, and unanimous vote, these proposals will be held until the December meeting for discussion as part of the 2013 budget.

<u>Sanctuary Video Screen and Enhanced Sanctuary Lighting</u> – There was no updated information regarding a video screen for the sanctuary. Reverend Griffin offered to check on the price for renting a lift to more easily access the lights. Tony Draper and Tim Smith will be asked to assist.

<u>Schools Ministry Update</u> – In response to questions expressed regarding the condition and staffing of the After-School program, Karen presented a list of current employees of the After-School program along with a weekly cleaning checklist. The large playground equipment needs immediate repair. With regarding to Pre-School issues, Ronnie will work with Jerry to address the need for fencing around the window wells. No decision was made regarding mulch for the small playground pending an estimate.

<u>Pavilion Anti-Erosion Update</u> – Beth stated that she has not yet heard back from the local Community Assistance Program office regarding potential funding amounts.

Door Replacement – Charles reported that he is still waiting on a quote for replacement and/or repair of doors.

Outreach Mission Project – The second outreach visitation is being planned and scheduled for December 2.

Fall Clean-Up – Barry presented a list of tasks and the person(s) who volunteered to oversee completion.

<u>Trophy Case Update</u> – Barry stated that he spoke with Kim Hampton who advised that several people she spoke with recommend that the church keep the case and trophies in their current location. The Trustees will continue to consider this item.

<u>Automated External Defibrillator</u> – Brad Johnson volunteered to set up a CPR training session. Barry recommended that all ushers and any other interested persons attend this class and be trained on the use of the AED units and in basic CPR.

<u>Church Electrical Upgrade</u> – This work is scheduled for the week following Thanksgiving. (Post-meeting edit: this work will be done the week of December 3.)

Scout Hut Bathroom – The permit application has been submitted.

<u>Updated Church Website</u> – Barry advised that Dee has updated the church's website and encouraged everyone to take a look at it.

<u>Valet Parking</u> – Barry made a motion that the parking lot spaces adjacent to the grass be designated for valet parking. Ronnie seconded the motion and it was unanimously carried.

There being no further business at this time, the meeting was adjourned at 9:45 p.m.
