Join us for an incredible journey to the historic roots of the Moravian Church. We will tour many of the sites well known to Moravians and be enlightened on their significance by Paul Peucker, archivist of the Moravian Church Northern Province.

Prague, Czech Republic, the City of a Hundred Spires. This capital city rests on the sloping banks of the River Vltava, the main artery of Bohemian waterways. Prague is rich in magnificent architecture – from the baroque to the modern. Cobblestone streets connect the old town with the cosmopolitan atmosphere of modern Prague. There is music everywhere – noon 'til night. *This is the site of the martyrdom of Jan Hus. We will also visit Kunvald, the village where the Moravian church was founded in 1457.* An optional excursion to Karlstejn Castle is available including lunch.



The Chalice (Kalich) Rocks – *the secret worship place of the persecuted Unitas Fratrum* – is a natural geological formation of rounded rocks forming a secluded labyrinth.

Herrnhut, Germany – *birthplace of the renewed Moravian Church.* In Herrnhut we will share the celebration of Jan Hus Remembrance Day at the Sunday service. We will also be able to share in the celebration of the 250th Anniversary of the Unity Archives in Herrnhut. Then visit their awe inspiring God's Acre, the Berthelsdorf Church and Zinzendorf's manor house. We will have the opportunity to visit the Moravian Archives and the Moravian museums and shops in the town.

Dresden, Germany – On the way to Dresden we will visit Gros Hennersdorf and other significant Moravian villages. In Dresden we will have a guided city tour and see the Swinger Art Gallery, the Meissener Porcelain collection and enjoy a boat tour on the Elbe River.
