1. Initial Deposit - \$350 per person, due with reservation form by January 15, 2014 to confirm your reservation.
  2. Final payment – due by April 25, 2014

## CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY

Some restrictions and penalties apply to your vacation investment. If you cancel your reservations, **YOUR RIGHT TO A REFUND IS LIMITED**, as set forth in the following schedule. All cancellations must be in writing and delivered to: Craig Mosebach, 582 Riverwoods Way, Bethlehem PA 18018. Date of postmark will determine applicable policy.

- A. Cancellations received prior to March 1, 2014 - initial deposit refund.
- B. Cancellations received between March 1 and May 1, 2014 - \$350 cancellation fee.
- C. Cancellations received after May 1, 2014 – no refund. Trip insurance is recommended.

## TRAVEL INSURANCE

### Option A: Comprehensive Travel Insurance

Fellowship Travel strongly suggests each passenger purchase Comprehensive Travel Insurance to protect you and/or your organization. Insurance must be purchased no later than 72 hours after final payment to Fellowship Travel and will not be effective until the premium has been paid and you have received confirmation. Comprehensive Insurance is 6% of your total trip cost and covers the items listed below. ### Option B: Medical Insurance

## PASSPORT
