# 125 Years of UNION CROSS MORAVIAN CHURCH HISTORY Part IV

The cornerstone for our current sanctuary was laid in a special ceremony on May 31, 1981. The sanctuary was completed in 1982 (our 89<sup>th</sup> year).

On January 24, 1982, there was a special consecration service that began in the old sanctuary and ended with a procession to the new sanctuary. A lovefeast also took place in the afternoon with the leading of Rev. Iobst.

1983 was our first year participating in the Church League softball league where we lost every single game; however, we won the sportsmanship award.

In 1984, we took our first mission trip to Bethel, Alaska to help with the construction of the Seminary building. In the years following, we would maintain a relationship with the Alaskan Moravians with further mission trips there. Other mission trips included Honduras, Jamaica, and Nicaragua.

In 1989, the old sanctuary was transformed into what is now known as the office complex with Sunday School rooms upstairs. The building was dedicated on September 10, 1989 after a picnic supper.

Since 1989, we have been engaged in God's work through various opportunities for fellowship, education, and mission. Each opportunity blessed by the hard work and dedication of UCMC's members, young and old.
